WHEREAS, Sioux Falls has a rich history of entrepreneurship and has fostered the creation of thousands of businesses of all shapes and sizes. Sioux Falls' homegrown businesses have created jobs, driven innovation, attracted capital and provided needed goods and services to our region.

WHEREAS, Sioux Falls was recently recognized as the number one small city for business and careers by Forbes Magazine. Forbes selected Sioux Falls for its job growth, low cost of living, low cost of running a business, income growth, economic growth, quality of life and the education of its workforce.

WHEREAS, there are currently 30.2 million small businesses and startups in the United States, representing 99.7 percent of all businesses with employees in the United States. Small businesses and startups are also responsible for 65.9 percent of net new jobs created between 2000 and 2017.
